

THEATRE – PROJECT DESCRIPTION

To plan, coordinate and execute an educational and instructional theatre literacy workshop for twenty-five (25) school-aged children, ages 7-13.

Benefits of being involved in theatre productions include improved self confidence, leadership capabilities, collaboration and teamwork, and organizational skills.

Participants will have the opportunity to receive training from experienced practitioners in each aspect of theatre-making such as scriptwriting and then apply this training to the staging of a short theatrical play. The theme of the production must be selected from a Guam Legend.

Dates of workshops must be coordinated with CAHA for a total of fifty (50) hours; must be inclusive of supplies and materials; and must identify and confirm a venue for the workshop. At the end of the workshop, the participants must be able to stage a short theatrical play.

In addition to the request for quotation (RFQ), you must provide the following:

1. A detailed narrative
 - a. Of what the project will entail; and
 - b. The number of workshop participants; and
 - c. Timeline/ schedule of project; and
 - d. Other pertinent information, etc.
2. A detailed budget breakdown
3. Biography
