MINUTES

I. Called to Order

The meeting was called to order at 3:08 p.m. by CAHA Chair Monica Guzman. She noted that, in accordance with Open Government Law, the notice of the meeting was published in the Guam Daily Post on March 3 and 6, 2026.

II. Roll Call

Chair Guzman conducted the roll call.

III. Approval of Minutes – February 10, 2026

Chair Guzman stated that the next item on the agenda was the review and approval of the minutes of the February 10, 2026 Board meeting. Following a brief review, Secretary Kloppenburg moved to approve the minutes as presented. The motion was seconded by Member Bollinger. **Motion unanimously approved**

IV. Executive Director's Report

Before the Director presented her report to the Board, Chair Guzman thanked everyone for their participation in the visit by National Endowment for the Arts (NEA) Chair Mary Anne Carter and her team. During the visit, the NEA encouraged increased grant applications from Guam, discussed potential funding opportunities for FestPac XIV, and noted that a proposal for the Creative Forces program is currently under review. The delegation also

emphasized funding opportunities available to nonprofit organizations and individuals. The visit included meetings with local leaders and artists, as well as several site visits, all of which produced positive outcomes and strengthened prospects for future collaboration with MWR and DoDEA schools. The Board recommended that the Director prepare an official letter of appreciation to Chair Carter and her team on behalf of CAHA and the Board. In addition, the Board requested that a thank you letter be sent to Christian Gaines, President and CEO of Creative West, in recognition of the organization's generous support of the dinner and reception hosted for Chair Carter and the NEA delegation.

Director Taitague reported on the following:

A. CAHA Financial Accounts – Bank of Guam

Director Taitague reported that a detailed financial report, including account balances and Time Certificate of Deposit (TCD) information held at the Bank of Guam, was included in the Board packets for review and reference. She noted that Account No. 4902 reflected a significant deposit resulting from the Creative Aging grant awarded by NASAA. The Board recommended that the Director schedule a meeting with Amoretta Carlson at the Bank of Guam to obtain a better understanding of the TCD investment statements and the related financial information and values.

B. Creative Aging Grant

The Director announced the receipt of \$77,500 from the National Assembly of State Art Agencies (NASAA) for a Creative Aging grant called "Manamko para Todu" which will fund arts programs for seniors over the next three years and focus on honoring elders through cultural arts engagement.

The grant will support monthly sequential arts learning activities in villages, including traditional practices and contemporary art forms. They discussed potential activities for senior centers and dementia programs. Chair Guzman asked the Board members to email suggested activities to Jackie. The Director added that she would work with Jackie on developing the detailed scope of work. The Board recommended that language be drafted for an RFQ/RFP for a nonprofit organization to administer and execute the project.

C. Percent for the Arts

Director Taitague reported that the Percent for the Arts documents remain at the Attorney General's Office pending review.

D. Art Bank and Website

Director Taitague reported that the Art Bank inventory and website catalog have been uploaded to the agency's website. She added that the website catalog is live but continues to be populated with additional artwork records. The Board requested that quarterly reports be provided on the status of the Art Bank and website updates.

E. Artist Directory

Director Taitague reported that the Artist Directory is about 60% completed. Included in their packets is a report from Program Coordinator II Duenas regarding his progress on the directory.

V. Board Action

Director Taitague requested the Board's ratification of an e-ballot vote approving the reallocation of funds originally designated for CAHA's Arts and Humanities Month in October 2026 to cover expenses associated with the NEA visit, as outlined in the attached email. Following a brief review of the correspondence, Member Bollinger moved to ratify and approve the prior e-ballot vote authorizing the reallocation of the Arts and Humanities Month funds for NEA visit expenses. The motion was seconded by Secretary Kloppenburg.

Before proceeding to old business, Director Taitague informed the Board of the passing of Master Techa Rosita Duenas Osborn earlier that week. The Board expressed its condolences and noted with sadness that Master Osborn had been recognized with the title of Master by CAHA less than six months earlier, on December 30, 2025. The Board discussed arrangements for sending a floral tribute for the funeral services, with expenses to be covered through the NAF account. Members also briefly discussed attendance at the funeral, scheduled for March 17, 2026, at Our Lady of Guadalupe Church in Santa Rita.

A. Maga'håga Art Awards

Chair Guzman expressed her interest in serving as Chair of this year's Maga'håga Art Awards. The Board discussed plans for the event and agreed that the program would be managed in house rather than through an external event planner. A reservation has been secured with Leo Palace Resort for the awards ceremony on October 3, 2026; however, an RFQ for the venue will also be distributed to local hotels for consideration.

To reduce costs, the Board, with assistance from staff, will oversee the planning and implementation of the Maga'håga Art Awards, including nominations, the silent auction, door prizes, entertainment, demonstrations, and ticket sales. The event will be organized within the existing \$25,000 budget, supplemented by monetary and in-kind donations to offset additional expenses. An RFQ for the venue would be sent out to the hotels.

B. Master's Program

The Director reported that the Master's Program remains unchanged and is currently status quo.

C. Percent for the Arts

The Director reported that, to date, no businesses have been issued qualifying certificates by GEDA for participation in the Percent for the Arts Program. She noted that she will follow up with GEDA regarding the status of qualifying certificates. Chair Guzman suggested that the former Marriott Hotel property remain on CAHA's radar as a potential project under the program.

D. FestPac XIV

Chair Guzman reported that planning for FestPac XIV remains status quo at this time.





Please accept my apologies; I want to clarify the funding details regarding my previous request for the upcoming village festivals. My understanding is that Inalahan Mayor is asking for 2,500

To provide context on our current budget, CAHA received an initial \$10,000 for village festivals in October 2025. Following the blanket voting session in February, several mayors have already leaving a remaining balance of \$3,750 from that allocation.

Additionally, the Program Manager for Creative West informed the Directors that Creative West will provide another \$10,000 by April 30, 2026, specifically designated for festivals. Please note must be utilized by September 30, 2026, as I must submit a final report to Creative West shortly thereafter pertaining to how the funds were distributed.

Given the hardships our communities faced following the storm, I believe it is vital that we support these village festivals to give back to our residents during these challenging times. I look forward to approving these funds to assist our local communities.
